



Study Abroad and Vote! Toolkit

Suggested Use of Toolkit Materials

This toolkit is meant to provide voter information to American students studying abroad. Study abroad institutions can distribute and use the enclosed materials to help make students aware of their voting rights when living overseas.

The Study Abroad and Vote Toolkit includes:

“Study Abroad- and VOTE” Leaflet

Print and handout this one-page document to students at their study abroad orientation. It provides instructions for how to register and request an overseas absentee ballot in three easy steps. Upload the document for students to see on your institution’s webpage. It can also be printed and posted on bulletin boards and in other public spaces.

Student Vote Banners

Print and post these banners on bulletin boards and in other public spaces. It includes a link to the Overseas Vote website.

Tear-Off Sheets

Print, pre-cut and post these tear-offs on bulletin boards and in other public spaces. Students can tear off a pre-cut strip with the link to the Overseas Vote website.

Facebook Cover Photos

These two banners are Facebook cover photo size (851 pixels x 315 pixels). Post them to your webpage for students to download and share on their own personal Facebook pages.

“I Voted” Online Badge

Post this badge on your webpage for download by students. They can then post to their personal social media pages to encourage their friends to vote.
